Minimum number of courses for international student

Exchange students must register for a minimum of 3 disciplines per semester

Application Deadlines

For the 1st semestre (starting in February): 31 October of the previous year

For the 2nd semestre (starting in August): 30 April

Language Requirements

Students need to have an intermediate level of Portuguese – B1. For external placements (internships or clinical electives for Medical Students): Portuguese – B2 (upper intermediate level)

For Medical Students upper intermediate level of English (B2) is strongly recommended as classmates and professor/preceptors at the hospital generally speak English.

Housing Options

Unichristus does not have dormitories for international students. The International Office helps incoming students to find adequate housing (private apartments or homestay) and provides guidance about the best neighbourhoods to stay in Fortaleza, the best way to get to the university by public transportation and other practical information.
